### Apparent Contradictions: Soul Ordeal in Spiritual Development

A small, largely invisible fraternity exists in and about the Anthroposophical Society. It has no membership list or outer organization. It is a union of souls bound by spiritual threads, a spirit association. They are united by their common activity: shared labors and struggles with the works of Rudolf Steiner. For them a hidden world exists in which they move about like the ordinary person on the earth's surface. It is the new world of ideas about the nature of reality, a world that Rudolf Steiner discovered and to which he gave thought forms. It is the world of the new mysteries accessible to those who acknowledge Steiner and exert spiritual effort studying his works. The members of this fraternity are Rudolf Steiner's occult brothers and sisters.<sup>ii</sup>

Like knights-errant they journey through the new spiritual terrain and do battle. They must battle the monsters that growl in the fire of their instinctive life like the poodle in Faustiii -- any time they try to enter the new domain. Once within the new world they are challenged by contradictions that threaten their trust in the bridge that Rudolf Steiner built, the bridge over the abyss separating the sense world from the new spiritual world. If trust is lost then the bridge vanishes and the knight finds himself back in the sense world. About trust in the master Steiner explains, Rosicrucian path, the guru becomes always more a friend whose authority rests on inner agreement. Here it is not possible to have any relationship but one of strong personal trust. Should but the slightest mistrust arise between teacher and pupil, then the essential bond which must remain between them would be torn apart, and any forces which play between teacher and pupil would no longer work."iv

Here follows the tale of a powerful contradiction that nearly overcame me. Wonder was opening the portals of my soul as I followed the thoughts in Rudolf Steiner's lectures on the Gospel of St. John (1908). These lectures picture some of the most profound and beautiful thought about the nature of Christianity. As I enjoyed the vista a powerful contradiction reared its head and almost unseated me.

To make clear what I experienced it will be necessary to reconstruct, at least briefly, some of the content. The lectures describe the consciousness of men who lived at the beginning of the Christian era and earlier. Steiner's investigations revealed that people of these past ages did not experience their personal identity in the manner of modern people. In those bygone ages a person identified himself as a member of his tribe or group. This was not an abstract matter. Those early people shared a common memory with their ancestors. Imagine that you had not only your own memories but also the memories of your parents, grandparents, great grandparents, etc. It was out of this experience of shared memory that the ancient Hebrew said, "I and father Abraham are one." Connection with the community through shared blood and memory created a strong bond of love among community members. They felt sheltered within the group ego. This love, however, did not extend to people outside the community. Moreover, group ego consciousness made a person less than truly free.

For true love to be possible, love that an individual freely gives to another, it was necessary for the individual ego to be separated from the group and to stand on his own. The Christ impulse is connected with the development of the truly free ego and the possibility for the ego to freely bestow love even on God.

A transitional moment between the time of group egos and individual egos is described in the Gospel of St. John as the wedding of Cana. Steiner explains that Cana of Galilee was a place where people of mixed blood lived. These people had broken away form the old blood ties and had married outside their tribes. So Christ went to a wedding between people of mixed blood. The Gospel tells how they ran out of wine and how, at the request of his mother, Christ turned water into wine.

Steiner explains this miracle as arising from a power that wove between Jesus and his mother. The usual rendering of the text, "Woman, what have I to do with thee?" is incorrect. The true text is, "This has to do with me and thy blood relationship." Steiner describes how what worked in the power of their shared blood made it possible for the wedding guests to experience the water as wine. Christ's time had not yet come and so it was still necessary to work with the old forces.

The contradiction that rose in my soul upon reading this passage concerned statements Steiner made a year later in 1909 in his lectures on the Gospel of St. Luke. There a most extraordinary revelation is given: the mystery of the two Jesus children. Only the briefest description can be given here. A careful review of the Gospel of St. Matthew and the Gospel of St. Luke reveals that both gospels present a genealogy of Jesus. Both genealogies include David the king. But the Matthew Gospel porcedes from David to his son Solomon the king while the Luke Gospel precedes to David's son Nathan the priest. Evidently the two gospels describe two different children. These two children have different experiences. For example, the shepherds visit the Nathan child of the Luke Gospel while the three kings visit the Solomon child of the Matthew gospel.

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Steiner's research reveals that a great initiate, Zarathustra, incarnated into the Solomon child and the child developed a considerable learning and stature. In contrast the soul incarnated into the Nathan child was very simple, indeed, Steiner claims this soul had never been incarnated before. It was, however, a very special soul that had been preserved from the Fall by the spiritual world. This child possessed a remarkable quality of heart that touched everyone around him but he was not wise and learned in the worldly sense.

The New Testament describes the finding in the temple. Here the 12-year-old Nathan Jesus is separated from his parents. They eventually find him teaching a group of Hebrew scholars. They are astonished at the change that has come over their previously simple child. Steiner explains that at this moment the ego of the great Zarathustra left the body of the Solomon child and entered the body of the Nathan child thus transforming him to the point of being almost unrecognizable to his parents.

Steiner's research discovers the following sequence of events. The Solomon child, now without an ego, dies. Then the Luke mother dies followed by the death of the Matthew father. The widowed father and mother marry and form a family. Eventually the second father dies leaving the Matthew mother to care for Jesus. In the Luke Gospel lectures Steiner underscores that after these events Jesus is living with his foster mother.

For the sake of completeness the great event, which occurs in Jesus' 30th year, should be described. At this time the Zarathustra ego has finished perfecting the three sheaths – physical, etheric, and astral — of Jesus. The ego makes the great decision to sacrifice the three sheaths and departs the body, giving it a last impulse to walk to the river Jordan.vi At the baptism the great Solar God, the Solar Logos or Christ, takes possession of the body and the God-Man's three years of earthly life begin.

The wedding feast of Cana takes place after the baptism. The contradiction that nearly unseated me is this: According to Steiner's research, as reported in the 1909 Luke lectures, the mother of Jesus, at the time of the wedding, was not his blood mother. It was his foster mother. But Steiner goes to considerable lengths in his 1908 lectures to make clear that the miracle of Cana is based on the working of forces of common blood!

This is not a minor point but goes to the heart of Steiner's thought in his very important John Gospel lectures. I wondered, Did Steiner make a major error in his 1908

lectures? Was he confused and only saw the correct state of affairs in 1909 when he lectured on Luke? But if he made such a major mistake in 1908 how could one be comfortable that he had not made another one in 1909? As such thoughts work in the soul the whole great spiritual landscape of Anthroposophy begins to dissolve. The student is losing trust in the teacher and the bond between them is shattering.

I did not give up struggling with the contradiction. As I reviewed the material it slowly dawned on me that the blood relationships Steiner describes in the John Gospel lectures are not limited to immediate relatives. Rather the relationship he characterizes is tribal: all the people related by the blood of Abraham flowing in their veins. But this tribal kinship certainly united the Jewish Jesus and his Jewish foster mother. Consequently Steiner's description holds perfectly well in light of the later revelations in the Luke lectures! With this realization I passed through a great ordeal of soul and the bond of trust with the master was renewed. I was free to continue my journeys through the spiritual landscape.

#### The Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres



The Platonists of Chartres in the 11th and 12th century lived strongly in Imagination, and conveyed spiritual truths via imaginative means. This brief article wishes to present the image of the West Facade of Chartres Cathedral and the image of the human being with the chakras. Mystery sites incorporate the concept of the body of man as the temple. A study of sacred architecture through the ages reveals many aspects of this mystery.

Rudolf Steiner describes the soul, the astral body and these chakras in chapter 5 of *Knowledge of the Higher Worlds and Its Attainment*. The entire book describes the path of development of the soul.

The site of Chartres Cathedral was devoted to the Virgin for many centuries, and various churches were erected there. Fire seems to have often destroyed the buildings, and in 1194 it was burnt for the last time. Not everything was destroyed, and it's believed the West Facade was started around 1144 AD. A relic believed to be a garment worn by the Virgin at the birth of Jesus is housed at Chartres.

The crown chakra at the top of the head is sometimes equated with Saturn and the 1000 petalled lotus, but also sometimes with 8 petals. Steiner does not mention it chapter 5. On the West Facade of Chartres



Cathedral at the top of the center between the 2 towers is a statue of Christ on an octagonal cupped base, which would be seen with the sun rising behind it. Below that is a statue of the Virgin holding her Child, flanked by 2 angels kneeling, which corresponds with the 2 petalled Jupiter chakra between the brows. Then a row of 16 knights below that stretches between the 2 towers, and relates to the 16 petalled Mars throat chakra. Then the beautiful 12 petalled rose window below that represents the 12 petalled heart chakra. Below that is a window with 10 panels in the center corresponding with the 10 petalled Venus chakra of the navel. Then comes the tympanum with Christ (surrounded by the 4 fixed zodiacal figures) and arched with rows of 6 figures, and the apostles below him grouped in 4 x 3, but with 2 other figures added, 1 on each side, so that there is a 6 fold grouping there as well. This relates to the 6 petalled Mercury chakra situated between the navel and the base of the torso. Then the 4 petalled Moon chakra at the bottom of the torso corresponds with the square (4-sided) door through which one enters the cathedral. The relationship of the planets to the number of chakra petals could be discussed at another time. Many more mysteries are included in this architecture, but I just wanted to present this for the moment.
